



Scope: Removal and Reinstatement of PQ concrete, lean concrete, surface water drainage, sub-base and AGL system.

Details:

Gill Civil Engineering Limited (GCEL) was appointed by Galliford Try to undertake the rehabilitation of Taxiway Quebec at East Midlands Airport. GCEL was responsible for breakout/removal of existing pavement, lean concrete, surface water drainage and sub-base.

A new land drain system, AGL ducting and pits, sub-base, wet lean concrete, pavement quality concrete and Gatic slot drain system were installed as part of work. Work was carried out on days and nights in order to meet project deadline. All work was carried out in air-side environment.
